#### **KEY FINDINGS FROM REGI CAMP**

- 43 patients were diabetic
- 27 patients were hypertensive
- 6 patients had high blood sugar
- People did not take diabetes seriously
- People did not know that high diabetes causes eye complications and feet problems
- Cost of medicine was a big concern
- Access to medical facilities was very difficult for women and children
- AIMS will provide care to and track data of these patients in future camp visits.


## Volunteer Profile


AIMS has partnered with "Life for a Child" (LFS) organization to help children with diabetes.


